Introduction

The Council has published for consultation a Supplementary Planning Document as part of its emerging Local Development Framework. The document has been published in accordance with Regulation 17 of the Town and Country Planning (Local development) (England) Regulations 2004 and follows previous consultation undertaken in August 2006 and October 2007.

Title, Subject Matter and Area Covered

Title: Greater Blackfriars Planning Brief

Subject Matter: The Greater Blackfriars Planning Brief sets out the Council's preferred approach to the development of the Greater Blackfriars area of Gloucester, including proposed land uses, urban design, landscape design and community safety.

Geographical Area Covered: The document applied to the Greater Blackfriars area of Gloucester City.
