However, it should not be used prescriptively, and neither should all of its advice points be required to be included within new developments.</p> <p>In particular, the document should not place burdens on developers that go beyond the remit of planning policies.</p> <p>Kayterm considers that this draft SPD should be fully in accordance with the provisions of national planning policy.</p> <p>The Draft SPD should be revised to make specific reference to the appropriate policies in the 'Core Strategy' and 'Development Control Policies' LDD's.</p> <p>Similarly, the reference on page 1 of the Draft SPD to planning staff and the Council's Planning Committee using the guide "as supplementary planning guidance" should be amended to properly reflect the new system of Supplementary Planning Documents.</p> | <p>Agree.
