Notice of ballot

Notice is hereby given that:

In accordance with Part 4 of the Local Government Act 2003 and The Business Improvement Districts (England) Regulations 2004, I have been instructed by Gloucester City Council, as the billing authority for the area, to hold a ballot in relation to Business Improvement District (BID) proposals which have been submitted by the Canal Corridor Partnership.

Arrangements for the BID Ballot

The day of the ballot will be Thursday 6th August 2009.

Voting in the ballot will take place by post only.

Ballot papers will be sent out to non-domestic ratepayers in the designated area, which are liable for the BID levy, on or by Tuesday 7th July 2009. - *Tuffley Avenue
- Newark Road
- Ashville Road
- St. Albans Road
- Pearce Way/Capital Park
- Corolin Road
- Lower Tuffley Lane
- Woodrow Way
- *Cole Avenue

*Denotes part of Road/Avenue”

Deadline for receipt of ballot papers

Ballot papers must reach The Ballot Holder, Electoral Services, Council Offices, North Warehouse, The Docks, GLOUCESTER GL1 2EP no later than 5pm on Thursday 6th August 2009 (the day of the ballot). Ballot papers received after this time will not be counted.
