Matter 9: Minerals

Safeguarding of Minerals

- 76. Whether the approach to the safeguarding of minerals within the policies of the GCP is consistent with the Minerals Local GCP for Gloucestershire 2018- 20 (MLPG), and in conformity with JCS Policy SD3 of the JCS, and the policies of the Framework?
- 76.1 The approach to the safeguarding of minerals within the policies of the GCP is fully consistent with the NPPF, the recently adopted Gloucestershire Minerals Local Plan and JCS Policy SD3 Sustainable Design & Construction.
- In responding to Gloucestershire County Council's as Minerals and Waste Authority comments to the Pre-Submission GCP, proposed changes have been submitted that seek to address the concerns raised, and to be considered at the examination in public. These have been agreed through the Statement of Common Ground between Gloucester City Council and Gloucestershire County Council (SoCG3). They are further shown in CD010a 'Schedule of Changes Pre-Submission Gloucester City Plan Addendum' (references PM004, PM005, PM026, PM032, PM059, PM079, PM080, PM081, PM083, PM084, PM085, PM086, PM087, PM089, PM090, PM092, PM093, PM095, PM096, PM099, PM100 & PM101 and shown as a part of the GCP in CD010b 'Appendix 1 Tracked Changed Pre-Submission Gloucester City Plan'.
