From 1st October 2015 the Deregulation Act 2015 changed the standard duration of a Private Hire Operators licence to five years. It specifies that an Operator's licence may be granted for a period less than five years but only if the Council think that it is appropriate in the circumstances of an individual case. If it is your intention to go with the one year option you will need to specify the reasons why this is the case. The Council will consider these reasons before deciding to grant a one year Operators licence.

Your right to work in the UK will be checked as part of your licensing application, this could include the licensing authority checking your immigration status with the Home Office. You must therefore provide a document or document combination that is stipulated as being suitable for this check. The list of documents is set out in Annex A (this list is in your operator pack). You must bring the original document(s), such as a passport or biometric residence permit as indicated in our published guidance, so that the check can take place. The document(s) will be copied and the copy retained by the licensing authority. The original document will be returned to you.

If there are restrictions on the length of time you may work in the UK, your licence will not be issued for any longer than this period. In such circumstances, the check will be repeated each time you apply to renew or extend your licence. If, during this period, you are disqualified from holding a licence because you have not complied with the UK's immigration laws, your licence will lapse and you must return it to the licensing authority, failure to do so is a criminal offence.

If the applicant fails to provide document(s) as specified in Annex A (this list is within your operator pack) that demonstrates a right to a licence in accordance with your published application process, you should consider whether to offer a further opportunity to provide the document before refusing the application.
