Who do we share the information with?	This is for Council use only. However if any information about the subject arises during any investigation we may be required to share data with police, Environment Agency or primary regulator		
Is any information transferred to or stored in servers based outside the European Economic Area?	No		
How long do we keep your information?	For the period of time the subject remains registered at the address/premises where a local authority is satisfied that a statutory nuisance exists, or is likely to occur or recur		
Who do we collect information from?	The subjects involved in committing the offence, DVLA, Police, Land Registry		
What are the consequences if we don't collect the data?	If the information is not collected by the investigating officer the Council would not be able to consider various formal enforcement options
