What information do we collect about you?	For a personal registration- Name, contact details, type of activity taking place, criminal convictions, location of activity to take place, previous registration details of any. For a premises registration- premises name, name and contact details of applicant, type of activity to take place, number of treatment rooms and manager name.		
Who do we share the information with?	This is for the Council's use only. However, if underage treatment or tattooing is suspected we may be required to share this information with the police.

How long do we keep your information?	We hold this information for 3 years after the business has closed (if we are made aware of it) or the registration has expired. Personal registrations do not expire so we will keep this information indefinitely.
