<b>Why we collect information about you?</b>  <b>What is the legal basis for us collecting your information?</b>	Because a vehicle registered to you has been reported as abandoned.  Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1970 and DVLA Policy		
<b>What information do we collect about you?</b>	Name address, contact details		
<b>Who do we share the information with?</b>	Council contractors if costs need to be recovered		
<b>Is any information transferred to or stored in servers based outside the European Economic Area?</b>	No		
<b>How long do we keep your information?</b>	2 years		
<b>Who do we collect information from?</b>	The DVLA and the resident reporting the abandoned vehicle		
<b>What are the consequences if we don't collect the data?</b>	We cannot dispose of the vehicle or find out if it is abandoned or not		
<b>Are any decisions about you made by automatic means?</b>	No
