## ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT

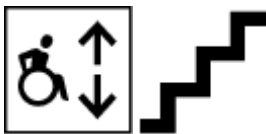


### Museum entrance

There is level access from the Library and from Eastgate Street.

For those with buggies, wheelchairs and guide dogs, an easy access route is also available from Eastgate Street (via the alleyway to the right of *Boots the Chemist*).

If you have any additional needs and require assistance, please let our staff know. Unfortunately the Museum cannot provide assistance around the Museum for wheelchair users.



### Lifts and access to galleries

Both galleries and special exhibitions are fully accessible.



### Parking

There are two parking spaces available for disabled visitors in front of the Museum. Unfortunately they cannot be reserved in advance, but other disabled parking is available nearby.



### Accessible toilets

There are accessible toilets on the Ground Floor.



### Guide and assistance dogs

Guide and assistance dogs are welcome. Dog water bowls are available.



### Seating

There are seats available in the café. Seating is also available in the galleries.
