<b>Why we collect information about you?</b>	To enable Gloucester City Council to determine whether you are eligible to be referred to Gloucestershire County Council's Vulnerable Women's Project		
<b>What is the legal basis for us collecting your information?</b>	To comply with the Vulnerable Women's Project criteria.		
<b>What information do we collect about you?</b>	Full Name, Address & former addresses, contact details, property ownership, family composition, ethnicity, date of birth, any disability or medical conditions, income/savings/assets including via DWP, criminal records and support needs		
<b>Who do we share the information with?</b>	<p>Gloucester City Council will only share your information with Gloucestershire County Council's Vulnerable Women's Project</p> <p>We will ask for your consent before we share your information except when we are required by law to share it, for example when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• we believe there is a risk of serious harm to you or someone else</li> <li>• we are required to by the Courts</li> <li>• the Police want information related to a serious criminal investigation</li> </ul> <p>We follow national guidelines on best practice when we share information. We share information securely. Anyone who receives information from us is legally required to keep it confidential.</p>		
<b>Is any information transferred to or stored in servers based outside the European Economic Area?</b>	No		

<b>How long do we keep your information?</b>	Gloucester City Council generally keep your personal data for 6 years after we close your record.		
<b>Who do we collect information from?</b>	Mainly applicant, some supporting information from medical or other supporting/interested professionals (e.g. County Council), Land Registry, UK Visa's and Immigration, Probation, Police, Registered Providers, Landlords, Experian.		
<b>What are the consequences if we don't collect the data?</b>	If we are unable to collect the data, then Gloucester City Council will be unable to refer you to the Gloucestershire County Council's Vulnerable Women's Project.		
<b>Are any decision about you made by automatic means?</b>	Any decision made is carried out manually by a Housing Officer to confirm that you are eligible for the Vulnerable Women's Project
