RE: Building Regulations Approved Document S – Infrastructure for the charging of electric vehicles

Dear Inspector,

Thank you for bringing to our attention the recently published Building Regulation 2010: Approved Document S – Infrastructure for the charging of electric vehicles. Having read the document we have concluded that Policy G2: Charging infrastructure for electric vehicles of the GCP, and references to it, should be deleted from the Gloucester City Plan.

The new regulations will take effect on 15th June 2022 and contain an identical requirement for EV charging for residential parking spaces as the proposed GCP policy. In terms of non-residential developments, we do not wish to pursue a policy that would conflict with the new regulations. We are of the opinion that the new regulations make the GCP policy redundant.
