Part 2 Information Required- Adopted Local Application Requirements

Any other plan(s), information or statement(s) as may be reasonably required.

This could include the following:

• Existing floor plans (e.g. at a scale of 1:50 or 1:100)

This is required for all applications that involve the use or retention of a building, Extension or other structure.

• Existing elevational plans (e.g. at a scale of 1:50 or 1:100)

This is required for all applications that involve the retention of a building, Extension or other structure.

• Existing site survey plan

This required for all applications and should show the extent of the use, operation or activity clearly marked.
