Elections Staffing

Why we collect information about you?

The Electoral Registration Officer and Returning Officer are data controllers and collect personal data directly from you to comply with your request to be considered for elections and canvass delivery work. We only collect the personal data we need in order to do this.

What information do we collect about you?

Name; address; Date of Birth; National Insurance Number; Nationality; Bank Account Name; Bank Account Number; Sort Code.

We request an e-mail address and telephone number so that we are able to contact you using those details to seek your availability for any elections or canvassing duties that arise.

We also collect and retain copies of documentary evidence of your Right to Work in the UK as this is a legal obligation of employers.

Who do we share the information with?

We share your information with our payroll provider in order to arrange payment for any elections or canvassing duties that you undertake.

We may share your information with neighbouring councils if you give consent for us to do so.

Is any information transferred to or stored on servers based outside the UK?

No.

How long do we keep your information?

We will keep your information as long as you remain on the elections staffing register. We may periodically review our database, but if you want to be removed, you should inform us by emailing elections@gloucester.gov.uk

Once you are removed from our database, we will remove all information we hold for you for staffing purposes other than your Right to Work evidence. We securely store your Right to Work documents for two years after your employment ceases and will then securely destroy this information.

Who do we collect information from?

We collect the information directly from you when you submit an application for inclusion on the election and canvassing staff register.

What are the consequences if we do not collect the data?

You will not be able to undertake elections or canvass delivery work.

Are any decisions about you made by automatic means?

No automated decisions are made about you.
