Reclaim the Night

Inspired by women's marches in the USA, Reclaim the Night began in the UK as a response to the advice given to women around their safety during the case of a serial killer active in northern England. Women were encouraged to stay at home in the evenings and not go out after dark. The first protest march was on 12th November 1977.
