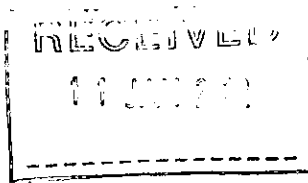

**Re:- Barnwood Arboretum - 14 Grovelands Barnwood.**

Further to receipt of your letter and Application form, we return the same filled in as requested.

In addition, may we advise that we are experiencing large amounts of debris, large branches etc. during and after high winds.

We can also advise a Lime Tree of similar size in an adjacent garden fell down a year or so ago. We and our neighbours are concerned that due to the height and size of this tress, in the event of the tress falling, would cause major damage to adjacent properties and a risk to life.

That said, we appreciate the tree and would like the tree reduced in height and pollarded to reduce the risk of the tree falling over in the future.

We are happy to employ a specialist tree surgeon company to carry out the work early next year, prior to commencement of the Spring.
