In exercise of its powers under the above-mentioned Act and Order the City Council as the Local Planning Authority REFUSE PERMISSION for the development described above in accordance with the terms of the application and the plan/s submitted therewith for the following reason/s:

By reason of the siting, design, overall scale and massing of the proposal would result in an overdevelopment of the subject property which would not be subservient to the existing property, to the detriment of the character and appearance of the host dwelling and the street scene. As such the proposals are contrary to policies SD4 and SD14 of the Gloucester, Cheltenham and Tewkesbury Joint Core Strategy (2017), The Gloucester City Council Home Extension Guide Interim Adoption Supplementary Planning Document (2008) and the guidance contained in the National Planning Policy Framework (2021).
